1. What are the notes and numbers of each guitar string?
2. What rhyme could we use to remember these?
3. Find the thickest string. What is it called?
4. Find the thinnest string. What is it called?
5. How are acoustic and electric guitar notes different?
6. Which fret is the first fret marker on your guitar on?
7. What letters are in the musical alphabet?
8. How many frets are between a whole step gap?
9. How many frets are between a half step gap?
10. What note is on fret 8 of the E String?
11. Sharpen the A note (5th fret) on the E String.
12. Flatten the B note (2nd fret) on the A string.

Answers.

1. E,A,D,G,B and E. (6,5,4,3,2,1)
2. Elephants And Donkeys Grow Big Ears
3. The low E string.
4. The high E string.
5. They are exactly the same.
6. It will either be the 3rd fret or the 5th fret. It varies!
7. A,B,C,D,E,F and G.
8. 2 frets.
9. 1 fret.
10. A C note.
11. If you want to sharpen a note you can go up by one fret, so the fret you will play will be A#. This fret will be the 6th fret.
12. If you want to flatten a note you can go down one fret. This will take you to the first fret of the A string, this note is Bb.
